SALES AND MARKETING INFORMATION

- Since launch (Oct. 25, 1990), Saturn has sold more than 116,370 cars through March 31, 1992.
- Sales for calendar year 1992 have been steadily increasing: 0

10,204 January February 13,035

March 16,757

- Saturn retail facilities continue to top sales per outlet for the 0 industry. In February, Saturn retailers sold an average of 103 cars per facility.
- According to a recent Automotive News study, Saturn averaged 776 0 deliveries per outlet in 1991, beating its nearest competitor by more than 100 units.
- For the 1992 model year (through March), Saturn has achieved an 0 approximate 1.7 percent share of the U.S. new car market.
- For the month of March, Saturn captured a 2.3 percent share of the 1992 U.S. new car market.
- Saturn has achieved more than 70 percent "plus" business to General Motors.
 - California nationally accounts for 12 percent of Saturn new car deliveries.
 - Florida accounts for 10 percent.
 - New York metro area accounts for 5 percent.
- As of March 31, Saturn has 152 retail facilities in 39 states and 0 79 major cities, including 15 in the metro New York area. Three more facilities are expected to come on line in the metro New York area by the summer.
